2. Tuition





Tuition is \$200/year, or \$175/year if paid by September 30, 2015 (early bird discount price); \$125/year for each additional family member/sibling who successfully auditions.

- b. Students who have not paid tuition or who have not agreed to a payment plan may not perform at the concerts.

9. Scholarships



The PYO is pleased to be able to offer scholarships to our deserving musicians, made possible by generous benefactors of the Orchestras.

- The Suzanne E. Anderson Memorial Scholarship is a \$500 scholarship to assist a deserving student in furthering his or her musical education. There is no requirement that the award recipient plan to major or minor in music in College. Money is awarded to pursue musical interests.
- The **PYO Excellency Award** is a \$500 award given annually to a senior PYO musician at the Spring Concerts.

To be eligible, a scholarship applicant must meet the following criteria:

- (a) A GPA of 3.85 or above;
- (b) A PYO member for at least one year with consistent attendance at orchestra practices;
- (c) Demonstration of leadership, honesty and respect; and
- (d) Performed at least 100 hours of community service since the freshman year of high school.
- Outstanding Ensemble Player Award: this is a scholarship awarded by a musician who wishes to remain anonymous. It is typically awarded at both the Winter and Spring Concerts.

10. Auditions for Next Year

Auditions for the 2016-17 season for the PYO & PJSO will be held on Monday, June 6, 2016 beginning at 5:00 p.m.

Auditions last 10 minutes, and they take place at Stroudsburg Jr. High School. Auditions are scheduled on a first-come, first-served basis. You will be notified with your exact audition time once your application is reviewed.
