## President's Message

The PYO's longevity is a testament to the many volunteers and donors who contribute time and money to help our students make beautiful music. Recently, we have been fortunate to be able to award scholarship money to students because of generous donors excited by our program who want to reward the achievements of our musicians. There are two donors who preferred to avoid the limelight but whom I must acknowledge.

The first is Lynn Zhang and her family. The Zhangs fund the PYO Excellency Award, a scholarship for students with high academic credentials who donate significant time to community service. The Zhang family just created a second scholarship which we expect to award for the first time at the Spring Concerts.

The second donor is Donald Dal Maso, founder of the L'Archet Concert Group. Don, an accomplished professional violist, initially funded what we informally called the "anonymous donor" award but which became the "Outstanding Ensemble Player Award." L'Archet has been hosting an excellent classical music concert series at the Cohen Center and has offered complimentary tickets to PYO students to hear first-rate performances. ## Introducing our PYO Soloists for the 2016 Spring Concerts



### **Luke Simons**

Luke, our principal clarinetist, has been a member of the Pocono Youth Orchestra for six years. He is a twelfth-grade honor student at Southern Lehigh High School where he is a member of the National Honor Society and SADD. Luke also plays the piano and saxophone and enjoys singing. At SLHS, Luke is a member of the SLHS Concert Band, Marching Band (Drum Major), Jazz Band, Concert Choir and Meistersingers. Luke has studied clarinet and saxophone with Anthony Simons, along with additional clarinet study with Ricardo Morales of the Philadelphia Orchestra, piano with Irmgard Pursell and voice with Megan Durham. During the past four years, he played

clarinet in the Lehigh County Band Festival. During the past five years, Luke was selected by audition to participate in 14 PMEA Music Festivals for Band, Orchestra and Choir. Most recently, he won the principal clarinet chair in both the PMEA District 10 and the Region V Band Festivals, and served as second chair clarinetist in the 2016 Pennsylvania All-State Band. For the past seven years, he has received superior ratings for his piano performances at PMTA's Achievement Award Auditions, and has performed in Honors Recitals. He has also been on stage for his high school theater productions of 42nd Street (Ensemble), Shrek: The Musical (Pinocchio), Sound of Music (Max Detweiler), The Drowsy Chaperone (Robert Martin), and, most recently, Carousel (Enoch Snow). He is most honored to have been chosen as a recipient of the 2016 Lehigh Valley Music Education Award and the AFM, Local 45 Music Scholarship. He enjoys playing in the PYO because it gives him a chance to perform with other advanced musicians. Luke will be attending the Mason Gross School of the Arts at Rutgers University to major in Clarinet Performance.

Luke is featured as clarinet soloist in Nikolai Rimsky-Korsakov's Capriccio Espagnol, Op. 34. He will also be performing John Williams' Air and Simple Gifts in a chamber ensemble along with pianist, Amy Zhang.



### **Aikaterini Stylianides**

Kaiti, our concertmaster, is a graduating senior from Stroudsburg High School. Kaiti plans to attend the University of Hartford in the fall to major in Acoustical Engineering. She has been a violinist in the PJSO and PYO for the past 6 years. In addition to PYO, Kaiti also plays the violin in her school's Pit Orchestra and Chamber Orchestra. She sings in Stroudsburg's Concert Choir and Chorale, and plays the flute for the Concert Band and Marching Band. To further enhance her passion for music, she has attended several summer music camps including sessions at Marywood University, Elizabethtown College, Millersville University, the Académie

internationale de musique des Graves, and the Techne Quartet Music Camp with fellow quartet members, Christie Lee, Sarah Chesko and brother, Tony. As a student advocate for promoting music, she has assisted with string workshops presented by violinist and luthier, Michael Montero, and violinist and music educator, Wendy Wilson. Kaiti is in the top ten percent of her class and holds high honors

awards for academic achievement. In her down time, she enjoys baking, reading, and learning to play different instruments.



### **Amy Zhang**

Amy, our pianist, is a graduating senior from Notre Dame High School where she is the Valedictorian of her class. Amy has studied piano for twelve years with Mrs. Kelly Scheer and would not be who she is today without Mrs. Scheer's guidance. For the past two summers, Amy has had the honor of studying under Mrs. Ingrid Clarfield at Westminster Choir College's High School Piano Camp. In addition, she has participated in the Piano Teachers' Forum of New Jersey adjudications, receiving an "Outstanding" ranking. She has played piano with the PYO for the past two seasons and is very grateful to have had the opportunity to perform with such a wonderfully talented group of musicians. In the fall, Amy will be

continuing her studies at Dartmouth College, where she will most likely major in Economics and definitely minor in Music before moving on to the Tuck School of Business. Amy hopes to study abroad sometime during her college years and eventually contribute to the global market.

Amy will be featured on piano in Frédéric Chopin's Étude Op. 10, No. 12 in C minor, known as the Revolutionary Étude. She will also be performing Fauré's Elegy with violinist, Kaiti Stylianides, and performing Williams' Air and Simple Gifts with clarinetist, Luke Simons.
